MUSIC

We have had a great start to the term in Music with students showing great enthusiasm towards singing, playing, composing and responding to music.

To start the term off we focused largely on body percussion, this helped students to learn rhythms and patterns whilst utilising their bodies as an instrument.

The upper school learnt songs about geography and worked well to compose their own body percussion rhythms to share with the class. We moved onto playing rhythm sticks and even learnt to play cups whilst singing along to the popular song The Wellerman by Nathan Evans.

The early years have been learning about the different musical elements, with a focus on dynamics and tempo. Students have been learning to play untuned percussion instruments such as triangles, castanets, drums, rhythm sticks, maracas and claves. We have learnt a number of folk songs that involve call and respond, as well as songs focusing on Australian animals. The Grade 1/2 class have been learning Never Smile at a Crocodile and the Grade Prep class have been learning The Fairy Penguin Strut.

Students look forward to performing songs they have learnt at Gudjinah in the coming weeks.
