Media Arts

Junior students (prep-2):

Students will learn about the art of Media Art and how this is different from Visual Arts. Students will focus on developing skills and technique in media arts, especially around photography. Students will learn to use a digital device to take and capture photos that tell a story or capture a moment in time. Students will be able to discuss other forms of media art and comment on other artists work. Students will also be able to respond to their peers art work and present and discuss their own artwork.

Students will focus on using an i-pad for capturing portraits of themselves and others. Students will be able to present their portraits to convey a story or message. Students will be able to manipulate their photographs to alter a message or story and present this to their peers and teacher.

Senior students (grade 3-6)

Students will revisit their understanding of Media Art and how this is different from Visual Arts and other art forms. Students will focus on developing skills and technique in media arts, especially around photography and manipulating photos to tell a story or convey their own meaning within the art piece. Students will plan a project around the theme of “moods” to capture a particular mood and convey this mood and the story of their chosen mood to their audience.

Students in the senior years will also focus on bringing sound elements to enhance their media art “mood” project and be able to demonstrate purposeful skill and technique in this area. Students will learn about mood, how it is used and created within photography and demonstrate this knowledge and skill within their project. Students will also be able to respond to their peers art work and present and discuss their own artwork.
